### At Ratby we believe uniform is important for several reasons:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school;
- promotes a feeling of community and belonging;
- is practical and smart;
- is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be);
- makes pupils feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents and carers;
- has been designed with health and safety in mind.

### Non-compliance of the School Uniform Policy

The Headteacher and school staff will expect all pupils to follow the school uniform policy and will discuss with pupils and/or parents breaches of the school's rules on appearance or uniform. Pupils will be reminded of the uniform policy and asked to remove items or not to wear specific items the next day. If pupils do not comply with the school uniform policy the following day, consequences may take place, such as:

- Confiscation of banned item(s) for collection by parent / carer
- Having to wear spare uniform supplied by school for the day
- Having to remove make-up or nail varnish using remover supplied by the school
- Parents contacted and asked to bring in the appropriate clothing.

# **Uniform Rules**

## **Jewellery**

- One pair of small sleeper or stud earrings is permissible. Pupils will nee to remove these for PE and Swimming lessons or ideally not wear them for school on these days.
- No rings /bangles/bracelets/necklaces (unless they are for a religious beliefs)
- A standard watch is permissible—but not an iPhone /Apple watch /Fitbit

#### **Nails**

- No acrylic/false nails.
- No nail varnish is permitted.

#### Hair

- Simple Jade, Green & White gingham or plain hair bands / clips may be worn.
- Hair colour should be natural, coloured hair dye/spray is not permitted.

#### **Outer Wear**

No gloves, scarves, hoodies, hats, cap or any other "outside wear" when inside the building

# **Uniform Specification**

Item	Guidance
Plain Black flat or low heel shoes or plain black trainers.	No sandals, high heels, wellingtons, doc- martins, The soles of all shoes/boots must be black. In winter months boots should be changed on arrival at school.
Grey (only) trousers or knee length pleated skirts or pinafore dresses	We do not allow denim, rivets, leggings, low-waisted trousers, chinos, trousers that are tight on the legs or made of stretchy material, trousers made of any fabric other than standard school trouser fabric nor any trousers that follow current a current fashion trend.  Ideally skirts should be fully pleated or pleated with front plain panel. No stretchy skirts/skater skirts/pencil skirts
Socks or Tights	Socks must be plain white or black. Tights must be plain, black or grey opaque. We do not allow leggings to be worn with skirts.
Jade green sweatshirt or cardigan (school jade green colour) or cardigan with the school's logo printed on them	We <b>do not allow</b> dark green cardigans or jumpers.
<ul> <li>Green and white knee length gingham dress.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>PE Kit</li> <li>A white round neck t-shirt</li> <li>A pair of navy or black shorts or leggings</li> <li>A pair of rubber-soled plimsolls (indoor) or</li> </ul>

- **Grey** knee length shorts
- A sun hat or cap.

- A pair of rubber-soled plimsolls (indoor) or trainers (outdoor games)
- In the winter, it may be necessary to bring a tracksuit or some other suitable warm clothing.
- Long hair should be worn up in a ponytail
